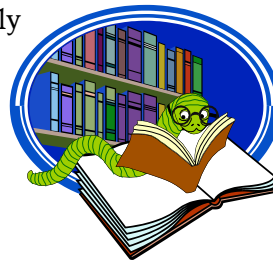

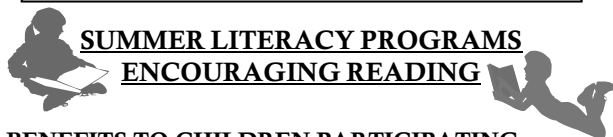

The Eastern Ontario Development Program (EODP) is a Government of Canada initiative which promotes socio-economic development in rural Eastern Ontario, encourages a competitive and diversified regional economy, and contributes to the successful development of business and job opportunities and sustainable, self-reliant communities.”

* \$5,000 Grant through their Local Initiatives Program. The purpose of the grant was to make the meeting room and moveable areas in the newly renovated library more accessible to the community as a space for workshops, training, small business information sessions etc. by adding required tables, chairs and blinds.

* \$20,000 funding under the Community Capacity Building Program. The Tyendinaga Township Public Library in partnership with the Deseronto Public Library received \$20,000 toward upgrading their automation system to allow access to their collections.

\$9,800 from The Ontario Trillium Foundation over one year to purchase shelves and furniture for a new collections space in the library
